#### The event

- 1. Held at the Goodooga Preschool, 6 Doyle Street, Goodooga, from 10am to 2pm.
- 2. Goodooga is in the Brewarrina Shire on the of the Bokhara River. It is approximately 121 km north from Brewarrina, Lightning Ridge, its closest community and is approximately 20 kilometers south of the Queensland border.
- 3. Coordinated in partnership with Gainmara Birrilee Preschool and Goodooga Preschool as part of the Brewarrina Murra in Murra (Hand in Hand) Spiritually Building a Stronger Future Project, that aims to bring young Aboriginal children, their families, and Elders together in a culturally safe environment, to connect young Aboriginal children and their families together and with their community.
- 4. Funded through a Children and Young People Wellbeing Recovery (Storm and Flood) Grant, this Children and Young People Wellbeing Initiative project is

jointly funded by the Commonwealth and the New South Wales Government under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

- 5. Attended by an estimated 16 Children, Families, Elders Community members and Agency representatives,
- 6. Organisational role, information shared by Gainmara Birrilee Preschool and Contact, Murra in Murra (Hand in Hand) initiative and this project.
- 7. Discussions then focused on what would make a difference for Goodooga Aboriginal children and families and valued programs in the community. The Goodooga Central School is appreciated with comment made about the School's good attendance rates and Playgroup (Parents as Teachers) is offered at the School on a Monday. Needs surrounding early intervention screenings (developmental checks/ speech), birth certificates were raised.

- 10. Agencies in attendance were Mackillop Family Services, Goodooga Preschool, Gainmara Birrilee Preschool and Contact representatives.
- Brewarrina sourced catering items and groceries were offered in these arrangements, with a delicious selection of fresh mixed sandwiches and wraps, fruit platters, water, provided for morning tea and lunch. A child's birthday was celebrated at lunch time, with special individual birthday cupcakes especially enjoyed by the children at the conclusion of the event.
- 12. Promoted by word of mouth and with event posters shared directly to families by the Goodooga Preschool .
- 13. Attendees provided positive feedback as to the valuing of the day.
